C. C. (RANDY) STEWART

Mr. Stewart is a Principal with Alpha Petroleum Services having over forty years of experience in the oil and gas industry. Randy has worked with major, mid-size, and small independent operating companies, primarily in economics, planning, and engineering/line management positions. Prior to forming Alpha Petroleum Services with L.V. McGuire in 2002, he was Group Vice-President with Kerr McGee, reporting to the CEO and responsible for K-M's worldwide production operations, refining and marketing, and the K-M Coal Corp subsidiary. Experience within the oil and gas industry includes a broad variety of activities:

- Randy spent 18 years with Exxon (initially with Humble Oil & Refining), working engineering positions in production and reservoir engineering in the East Texas, Mid-Continent and South Texas Divisions, followed by operations and engineering management assignments. He was Exxon's Western Division Production Engineer responsible for the Prudhoe Bay facilities development, the Mid-Continent Division Operations Manager in charge of the Sheep Mountain CO₂ development project and the Means Field re-Drill project, and Esso Expro Operations Manager in the North Sea responsible for the Fulmar and North Cormorant field developments, and the Shell-Esso Joint Underwater Development Team. He also served in London as Esso Europe's Corporate Planning Manager during 1980-81.
- He left Exxon to become Vice-President of Production for Hamilton Oil Corporation in Denver, subsequently returning to the North Sea to serve as Sr. VP-Technical where he led Hamilton's efforts in unitization of the Bruce gas condensate field, chaired the Ravenspurn Operating Committee, and managed Hamilton's field development activities and their Economics and Planning Group.
- In 1990, he joined Kerr McGee Corp as Sr. Vice-President of Production responsible for worldwide production activities. In 1993, he added management of K-M Coal Corp and K-M's refining and marketing activities to his portfolio.
- Over his career, Randy has managed directly, or furnished oversight of project management teams that developed fields ranging from marginal to world-class in size. His skill set is strong in planning and economic evaluation, but he also has led negotiating efforts with other operators and governments, and has managed efforts to secure regulatory/governmental approvals. He also has managed large (1,000+) production organizations. He is adept at solving unstructured problems.

Randy grew up in Arkansas, USA and attended the University of Arkansas on an athletic scholarship where he graduated summa cum laude with a degree in mechanical engineering and was named Academic All-American and an All-Southwest Conference footballer.
